- 3. Using Malaysia's National Culture Policy as an example, and by looking at the relationship between culture, ideology and power, discuss the conflicts inherent in the molding of a 'national culture'.
- 4. Cultural dependency exists and is perpetuated through collaboration between local and transnational actors. Discuss with relevant examples.
