1. Three ways of listening are total tune out, partial listening and total listening. Explain each of them.

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
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(i) Total tune out

2. Interference is anything happening simultaneously within and outside the speaker or listener, making listening difficult. List five examples of interference from outside.




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3. To enhance your speaking and listening skills, you need to study the nonverbal body language communication. List five examples of such nonverbal body language.
