- 4. Raja Rao suggested that "in a language that is not one's own, one needs to communicate a spirit that is one's own". Discuss how any one author that you have studied attempts to do this, with particular emphasis on stylistic aspects.
- 5. Would you agree with the view that where great diversity exists, the short story is the best vehicle for a picture of life. Evaluate the above view with reference to what you would consider to be the merits of short stories studied on this course.
- 6. Evaluate the stylistic techniques employed by the authors in one of the following:
 - [a] The Mimic Men, or
 - [b] Kanthapura, or
 - [c] The African Child, or
 - [d] Things Fall Apart
