annually

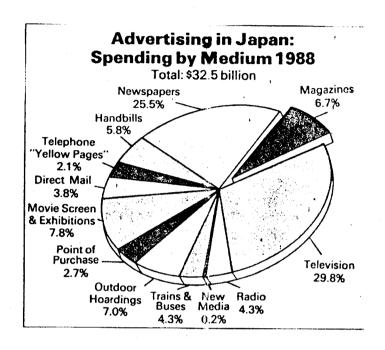
Magistrate: That's not acceptable to us

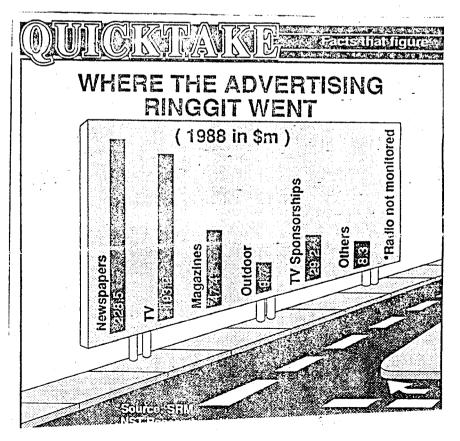
