 - (b) The more time parents spend teaching their children English, the better the children will speak.
 - (c) There are primitive languages with only a few hundred words.

What can you say about animal communication? Using evidence from studies conducted on animals -- bees, chimpanzees, dolphins -- describe the properties of animal communication systems. How does it differ from human language?

3. What is sociolinguistics? Describe explicitly what sociolinguistic study entails. Is sociolinguistics a vital aspect of language? Why?

4. According to the theory of operant conditioning proposed by the behaviourists -- a child spontaneously vocalizes in a random fashion: the child's parents reinforces these vocalizations, either positively or negatively: over time the child's vocalizations resemble the parents speech more and more closely and thus, they learn to talk.

What is your opinion of this theory? Is there an alternative theory that would reflect more accurately the process of language acquisition? Explain.
