 - [d] What is the Hierarchy of Difficulty principle. Explain its workings in the Contrastive Analysis Hypothesis.
- [a] What sort of background knowledge should a linguist have before he goes about comparing two sound systems.
 - [b] What are the **three checks** a linguist should **employ** when making a comparison of two linguistic sound systems?
 - [c] List and explain fully four (4) pronunciation problems a second language learner is likely to encounter.
- 3. [a] Name and explain fully four (4) elements that signal grammatical structure. Indicate how each can cause learning problems in a second language.

- [b] Explain four (4) problems a second language student is likely to encounter when learning grammatical structure.
- [c] What is Lado's three-step procedure for comparing two grammatical structures?
- 4. [a] Write very briefly on Form, Meaning and Distribution of words.
 - [b] Explain fully the likely problems that might arise when two vocabulary systems are compared.
 - [c] How do you go about comparing two vocabulary systems?
- 5. [a] Explain very briefly this statement: "Language and culture are inextricably intertwined"
 - [b] List any four (4) words and explain briefly the concept of cultural meanings of these words and how these can have a bearing on second language learning.
 - [c] Explain two (2) social formulas and how these could be misunderstood in a language learning situation.
 - [d] Explain two conflicting attitudes that can cause misunderstanding to a second language learner.
- 6. There are some pedagogical implications that can be derived from a comparison of the sound, grammatical and vocabulary systems of the first and second language.
 - [a] Review briefly any two (2) of the above.
 - [b] What are the techniques a second language teacher can devise to facilitate second language learning?
