First organised by PSA and PETAS in 2005, this year marks the 11th edition of the endeavour in realising it to become an exciting event at USM.

This was stated by the USM Vice-Chancellor, Professor Datuk Dr. Asma Ismail in her speech at the Gala Night 2016, held at the Dewan Tuanku Syed Putra (DTSP) here this evening.
