### **TEKS C**

#### **A parade of dinosaurs**

The richest known deposits of dinosaur remains lie in the Midwestern states of North America. In Texas, the Paluxy River, a tributary of the Brazos, is slowly meandering across a layer of mudstones. This was once the mud flat of an estuary. One day at low tide several dinosaurs wandered across it. One was a theropod, a carnivorous species that walked erect on its hind legs. The line of its three-toed footprints is still clear along one side of the present-day river, a furrow thrown up by its tail swinging between them. Farther down, the river has eroded more of the overlying rocks to expose in the same layer four immense circular prints nearly a metre across that were made by one of the huge plant-eating species. As the water ripples above them, it is easy to imagine that the river bed is not stone but still mud and that these huge giants were striding through the water only hours before.
