

Problem: False accusations and wrongful convictions are victimizations by the investigatory and criminal justice system Remedy: Resorting to scientific observations of crime scenes

## Objectives

- I) To elucidate that improprieties in 'observing' crime scenes per se involving equivocal deaths lead to imagine 'homicide' impelling the investigators, prosecutors and judges to accuse/convict an innocent individual wrongfully
- II) To stress that 'observing' a crime scene in situ is part of forensic science practice and 'crime reconstruction' is the responsibility of the forensic investigator, a forensic science generalist
- III) To recommend the following remedial measures a) rejuvenating 'forensic science generalists'
  - b) inclusion of forensic science crime scene management - as part of the law curriculum
