One of the signs of this novel's excellence is the brilliance with which Achebe has demonstrated the interrelation between sociology and psychology, between environment and character. *Things Fall Apart* is a novel of character and environment ... environment is character."(Eustace Palmer, in *An Introduction to the African Novel*, 1972). Discuss this statement.
