3. Discuss the views that have been put forward by linguists regarding second language acquisition in relation to first language acquisition. Include in your answer the similarities and differences that linguists have drawn to show the link and divide between the TWO kinds of acquisition. What are your own opinions on some of the more debatable issues concerning the TWO types of acquisition?

4. Explain Labov's class stratification as a factor in linguistic variation. Elaborate on this with reference to his and other linguists' research to demonstrate issues of class and language variation.

5. Why do you think people might want to maintain their language when they move to a new country? Discuss with examples the factors which contribute to language maintenance as opposed to those which favour language shift.

Ferguson's (1959) original description of diglossia refers to a very specific type of bilingualism or bidialectalism, where a particular speech community uses TWO related language varieties for different purposes. Discuss Ferguson's concept of diglossia and compare it with Fishman's extended concept of diglossia.
