Discuss this distinction between the TWO models using the sentences While Anna dressed the baby played in the crib and The horse ran past the barn fell.

3. The literature on language and the brain suggests that in the normal human brain, both hemispheres are involved, perhaps to differing degrees in language function. However, it is also evident that such bihemispheric involvement may not be necessary for reasonably normal functioning. Discuss this by citing evidence from experimental studies that have led to this conclusion.
